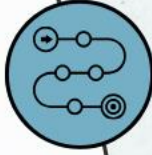




Learning Prioritization Plan



Data Collection and Building Understanding: 2022-2023
EES spends time in each building to observe student learning. The planning team conducts focus groups with teachers, staff, parents, and community members. The process also includes stakeholder surveys, curriculum audits, assessment audits, and data analysis.



Plan Development: 2023-2024
EES conducts a thorough analysis of all data collected and develops a concise, comprehensive action plan that addresses instruction and learning outcomes, enhances current systems in place, and suggests measures to sustain improvement.



Plan Analysis: 2023-2024
MSDNDT identifies a Guiding Coalition to oversee the analysis and long-term development of the LPP. Three teams are formed to oversee the implementation of each Key Priority Area. The KPA Teams conduct an in-depth review of the plan developed by EES and make adjustments and additions based on locally identified needs.



Plan Implementation: 2024-2025 to 2027-2028
Through the guidance of the Guiding Coalition and KPA Teams, MSDNDT implements the strategies outlined in the three Key Priority Areas, to build instructional and learning growth in Curriculum, Assessment, and Data Collection, Instructional Strategies, and Graduates Prepared to Succeed Alignment.



Continuous Review and Adjustment: Ongoing
The Guiding Coalition and KPA Teams continue to meet and review data collected through each of the KPA processes, to modify strategies and goals, and ensure ongoing and continuous progress in each of the three Key Priority Areas.
